KEYNOTE SPEAKER



H. Luke Shafer, PhD, is the Hermann and Amalie Kohn Professor of Social Justice and Social Policy and Professor of Public Policy at the Gerald R. Ford School of Public Policy at the University of Michigan. At U-M, he is also the inaugural director of Poverty Solutions, an interdisciplinary, presidential initiative that partners with communities and policymakers to find new ways to prevent and alleviate poverty.

Shaefer is one of the nation's leading scholars of poverty and social welfare policy. His research has been published in top peer-reviewed academic journals in the fields of public policy, public health, health services research, sociology, social work, and history, and his work has been supported by the National Science Foundation, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, and U.S. Census Bureau among other sources. He has presented his research at the White House and before numerous federal agencies, has testified before the U.S. Senate Finance Committee, and has advised a number of the nation's largest human service providers.



As a community, we all share the same goal of ensuring our children have the best possible start in life. To achieve this, we must prioritize building a strong foundation for learning, starting at a young age. One of the most effective ways to do this is by encouraging young children to read.

Research shows that reading can have a profound impact on kindergarten readiness. Children who are exposed to books regularly tend to have stronger language skills, a larger vocabulary, and a better understanding of fundamental concepts such as numbers, letters, and colors. This is particularly crucial for lower-income families who may not have equal access to educational resources.

In Washington State, the overall readiness rate for kindergarten is 52.5%. However, for some Pierce County districts with significant percentages of lower-income families, the readiness rate is below 40% for these children. By promoting reading to young children, we can help close this gap and give every child an equal chance to succeed.

The Dolly Parton Imagination Library provides free books to children* from birth to age five, ensuring that all kids have the opportunity to read at home. United Way of Pierce County is partnering with DPIL to promote family engagement and early childhood development, setting children up for success in all areas of life.

*Each child receives a free book each month from birth to age five.

Supporting this important program means giving every child an equal opportunity to develop a strong foundation in literacy and to be ready to learn when they reach kindergarten.


