

#### **FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS**



Departmental Expenditures: Under by \$268,000:

Salary and benefit line items are real savings of \$190,000

Estimating other real savings of \$30,000

Timing differences on other expenses

- Departmental expenditure line items over by \$5,000 None
- Endowment approaching \$3.5M compared to \$2.9M last year
- HVAC compressor broke \$55,000 to replace; Boys and Girls Clubs Hope Center payment anticipated to be less in 2015

#### **Updates:**

City proposal for UWPC to relocate to Hilltop and Parking lot sale Key Person Life Insurance - \$250,000 coverage (\$412 annual) The Finance Committee approved this insurance on Dona.

#### **Ensuring a Strong Start for Kids Asks**

 Continued investments in Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP); Early Achievers Quality Child Care; Birth to Three Home Visiting Services; and Washington Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills (WaKIDS).



#### **Ensuring Early Grade Success Ask**

- Implement Breakfast After the Bell for high poverty K-12 schools.
- Currently only 43.9% of eligible children who access the free lunch program also receive breakfast.



#### **Building Strong Families/Basic Needs and Supportive Services Asks**

Support continued investment in 2-1-1
 Resource and Referral.

 Support funding for the State Housing Trust Fund; Housing and Essential Needs (HEN); and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).



#### **Capital Improvement Ask**

- Support approximately \$350,000 capital budget request via Rep. Jake Fey and Sen. Bruce Dammeier to purchase the Burlington Northern property which will be developed into the first Urban Children's Art Park in Tacoma on the historical Prairie Line Trail.
- Partners in the Park endeavor are: City of Tacoma; Metro Parks; Children's Museum; Tacoma Art Museum and potentially the State Department of Transportation.
